Nordstrom Opens First Store in Irvine, California at Irvine Spectrum Center

The store also offers Cafe Bistro, an Ebar (espresso bar), live piano music, a family restroom, and an in-store alterations and tailor shop.

Earlier in the week, Nordstrom celebrated its opening with a gala party to benefit CASA of Orange County and Laura's House. Over 1,400 guests enjoyed hors d'oeuvres, live entertainment, a runway fashion show and the opportunity to do some "sneak preview" shopping. The fashionable fete raised \$150,000.
