WHEN: The first Nordstrom Rack opened as a clearance center in the lower-level of the downtown Seattle Nordstrom store in 1973. The first stand-alone Nordstrom Rack opened in 1983 in Clackamas, Oregon. As Nordstrom expanded to other parts of the country, Nordstrom Rack stores followed.

MERCHANDISE: Nordstrom Rack carries merchandise from Nordstrom stores and Nordstrom.com, as well as specially purchased items from many of the top brands sold at Nordstrom. Nordstrom Rack has the benefit of having a relationship with Nordstrom full-line stores and can offer customers a mix of merchandise from Nordstrom stores, or from many of the top brands that are carried in Nordstrom. Deliveries arrive weekly, offering on-trend styles across a wide range of categories. Each store's assortment is tailored to the community it serves.
